

Pozos Art Project

Summer 2010 Workshops

Workshop #1

June 13–20 Photography and Studio Art (Drawing, Painting, and Printmaking)
Mineral de Pozos (Guanajuato), Mexico

Fee: \$1,500.00; includes pick up and return to the Queretaro airport or the San Luis Potosí bus station; lodging with a Mexican family in Pozos, three meals a day, all photography darkroom materials and chemistry; digital inks and paper; art materials for drawing, painting and printmaking. (Does not include photographic film)

Payment: One-third of fee (\$500.00) is due upon enrollment (fully refundable if the student withdraws before May 1, 2010); balance of fee is due by May 15, 2010 (refundable only if the student's place in the workshop is filled by another applicant).

Workshop #2

July 5–24 Photography and Studio Art (Drawing, Painting, and Printmaking)
or
July 5–12 * Mineral de Pozos (Guanajuato), Mexico with travel to Veracruz, Mexico

Fee: \$2,500.00 for the full 20 days; includes pick up and return to the Queretaro airport or the San Luis Potosi bus station; lodging with a Mexican family in Pozos, three meals a day, all photography darkroom materials and chemistry; digital inks and paper; art materials for drawing, painting and printmaking. (Does not include photographic film)

Payment: One-fifth of fee (\$500.00) is due upon enrollment (fully refundable if the student withdraws before May 1, 2010); balance of fee is due by May 15, 2010 (refundable only if the student's place in the workshop is filled by another applicant)

* Applicants may apply for only the first eight days of Workshop #2 (July 5-12), prior to the group's departure to Veracruz. The fee (\$1,500.00) and payment terms for this option will be the same as for Workshop #1.

Arrival and departure information: Workshop participants should plan to arrive on the first day of the workshop (June 13 or July 5) at either a) the international airport at Querétaro, Mexico (airport code QRO) or b) at the central bus station or the Chavez bus station in San Luis Potosí, Mexico. They should plan departures on the day after the workshop (June 21, July 13, or July 25).
